Call for Papers

The British Machine Vision Conference (BMVC) is the main UK conference on machine vision and related areas. Organized by the British Machine Vision Association, the 15th BMVC will be held in September 2004 at Kingston University, Kingston upon Thames, London, UK. Paper submissions are invited, to be refereed on their originality, presentation, empirical results, and quality of evaluation.

Conference topics include (but are not limited to):

- image features and coding
- multi-view and stereo vision
- grouping and segmentation
- texture, shading and colour
- object recognition
- real-time and active vision
- shape and surface geometry
- medical and industrial applications.

BMVC2004 is a single-track meeting with oral and poster presentations. The proceedings will be available to delegates at the conference in hard copy and on CD and a selection of the best papers will be published separately in a special issue of the journal Image and Vision Computing.

In addition to the contributed papers, BMVC2004 will include presentations by invited speakers, and a pre-conference tutorial programme on Monday 6th September 2004.

Delegates will be able to view poster presentations and see demonstrations by both industrial and academic researchers exhibiting their work.
