International Conference on Systemics, Cybernetics and Informatics ICSCI-2005 is going to be held at Hyderabad, India, during January 06 – 09, 2005 along with a scientific exhibition. This conference would provide a large forum for international researchers and practitioners interested in sharing their experiences in the advances in, and applications of, various scientific disciplines classified under Systemics, Cybernetics and Informatics.
